Frank Edward Ray, 98 years old, was born June 6, 1922. He passed away on February 7, 2021 at home surrounded by family. 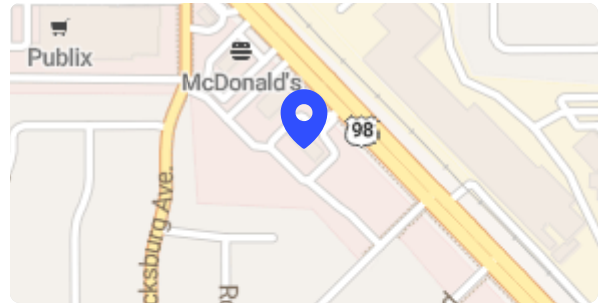
