Terry Malcolm Lennox was born on October 30, 1940, in Canton, Ohio, and passed into eternity on December 29, 2021.

A true Scotsman to the core, Terry was a faithful husband to Candace, and proud father and grandfather to Stacy, Brian, and Jacob. He loved Jesus, America, and was a Vietnam Veteran who served in the Air Force. He so loved his sister Susan, niece Beth, and nephew Rob, whom he considered like a son. Terry enjoyed the company of his favorite Auntie and Uncle, Nancy and Larry Huff, who live nearby.

In 1975, Terry became sick of the cold Canton, Ohio winters. He packed all of his worldly possessions into a bread truck and moved his family to sunny Florida. A choice he never regretted. He spent several years in Vero Beach, where he began working as a flight instructor for Flight Safety International. He later transferred to Lakeland and retired as the Director of Maintenance Training after 32 years with the company.

Terry enjoyed airplanes, cars, guns, eating out with friends, and watching Joyce Meyer on the computer every day to feed his soul. He spent many, many years driving his Stars & Stripes MasterCraft while pulling future waterski champions. 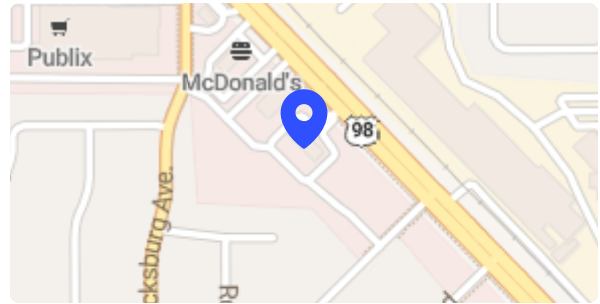
