**M**r. Stanley Joseph Saccoman, 80, passed away the evening of Thursday, August 17, 2023.

Stanley was born in Nashwauk, Minnesota to parents Stanley and Lenon (Ethier) Saccoman on January 20, 1943. He spent his childhood in Minnesota, and after graduating high school, he joined the US Army at the age of 18 and served from 1961 to 1964.
