A memorial service for Jan was held at Gentry-Morrison Funeral Home, Serenity Gardens Chapel, in Lakeland.



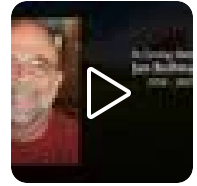

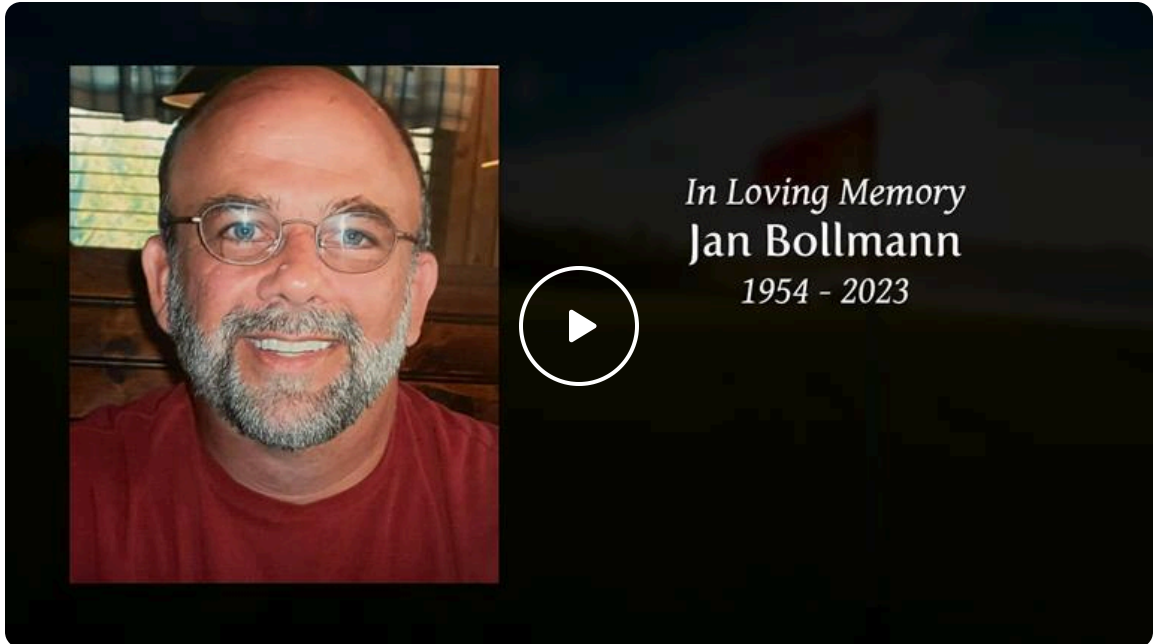
