## **Mr. Virgil Cox**

**M**r. Virgil Cox of Rome, GA, formerly of Lakeland, FL, passed away from this life and to his eternal home with the Lord on December 3, 2023.

He was born in Grundy, Virginia to the late Otis and Matilda Cox as one of eight children. He was of the Christian faith and was called to share the Love of God and blessings of Christ as a Baptist Pastor. He served faithfully in this capacity for years. Alongside his calling, Virgil had a career with the U.S. Army as a Materials Classifier, after his active service as a paratrooper. In his retirement, he found joy in service as a crossing guard in the Lakeland area for the Polk County Sheriff's Office. Until his passing, Virgil was a member of Liberty View Baptist Church in Silver Creek, Georgia.

He married the love of his life and Godly partner, Patricia J. Cox. She was a homemaker and mother. Their marriage flourished for fifty-six years until her passing in 2008.

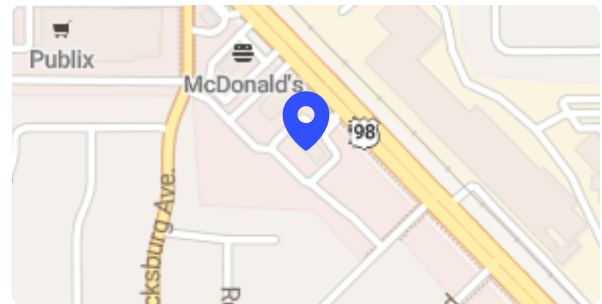

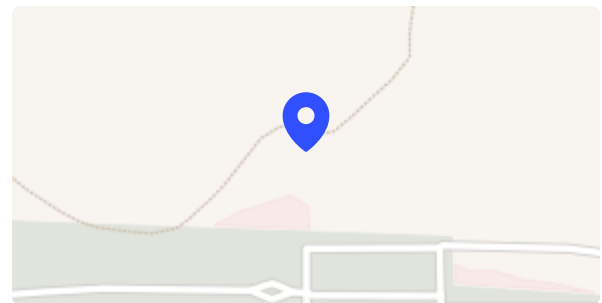

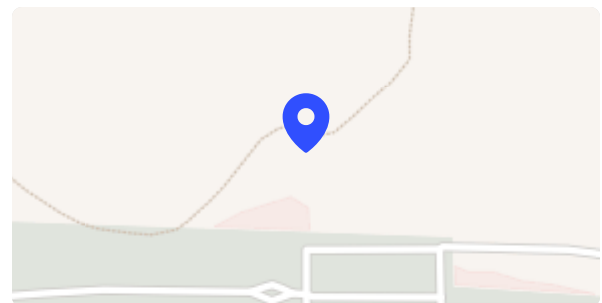
