In lieu of flowers memorial gifts are encouraged to the Florida Baptist Children's Home.



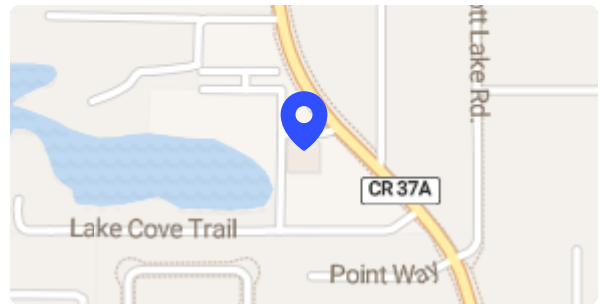

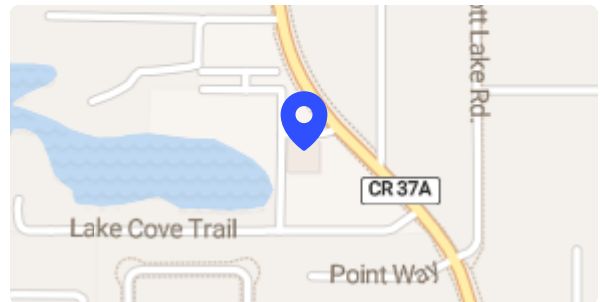
