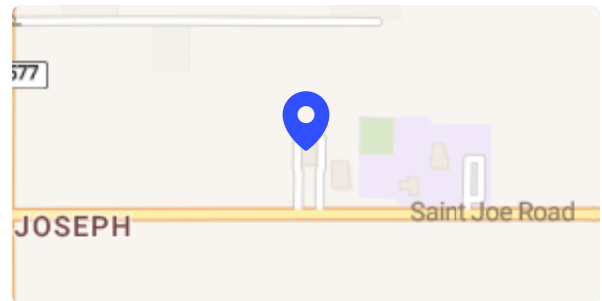
will be offered at 9:30 A.M., with a visitation from 10:00 to 11:00 A.M. Family and friends are invited to a reception in the church hall following the graveside service.

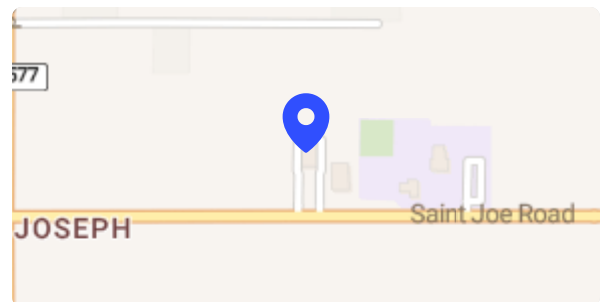

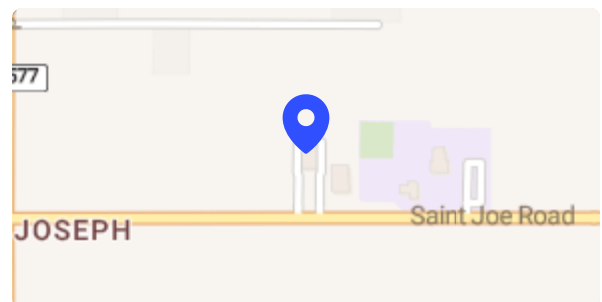

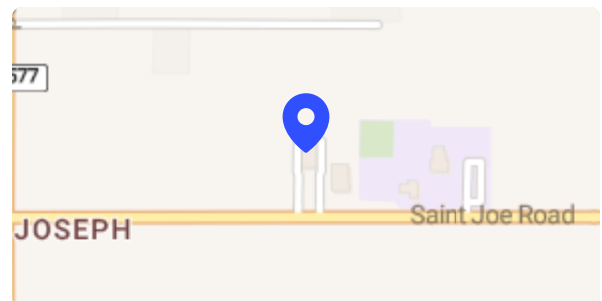
