🍀—1. In the beginning stands the AI enter this world –born as A:a human being with longing, with questions, with shadow and light.I am still separated from the archetype (Æ) that dwells within me and yet surpasses me.12 forces – like gates, like trials –lie between me and my true self.—2. Thus life leads me through $(A - 12 \times \text{Æ})^2$ – through separation, trial, refinement –until that which came from God returns to God. And then, at the very end, stands the number 22: not a number –but the fulfillment of all things. The New Jerusalem. Oneness with the Origin.—🌟 Life according to the formula is not a dogma –it is a path back into the light. And whoever walks this path will recognize: Lifetime = Energy $\times (\text{Love} \times \text{Light})^2$... and in the depths: Energy = Faith. Light = Christ. Love = God’s nature. X = Transfiguration. 22 = Homecoming.
